

H-1 B Cap Gap I-20 Request Form

The purpose of the form is to request an updated Form I-20 reflecting the Cap-Gap Extension. Current immigration regulations permit certain F-1 students with a pending or approved H-1B petition to automatically extend their F-1 status and work authorization (OPT or STEM OPT) beyond the end date of their current employment authorization through September 30. This period, known as the Cap-Gap, applies only to students whose H-1B petitions were filed with a request to change status within the United States. This extension allows eligible students to continue employment while awaiting the start of their H-1B status on October 1.
